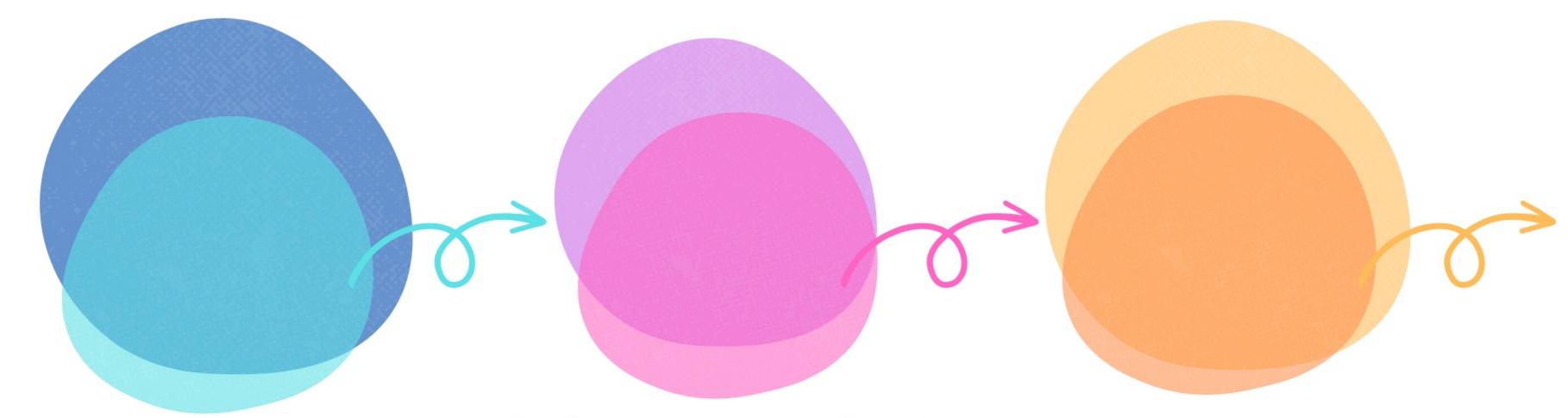


"THREE-POINT SHOT"

Everybody takes a chair and finds their place in the space.

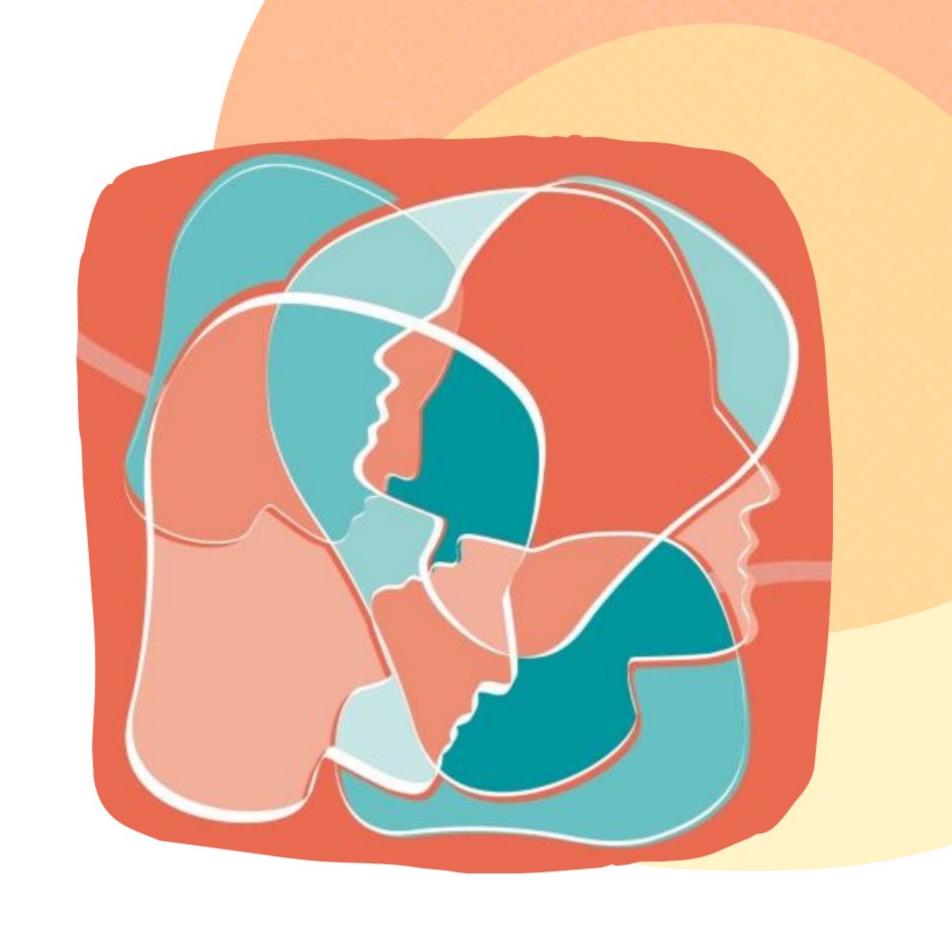
Takes a seat and makes a ball from the paper that a teacher distributed.

The teacher places a bucket in the classroom in such a way that the chance to "make a goal" varies.

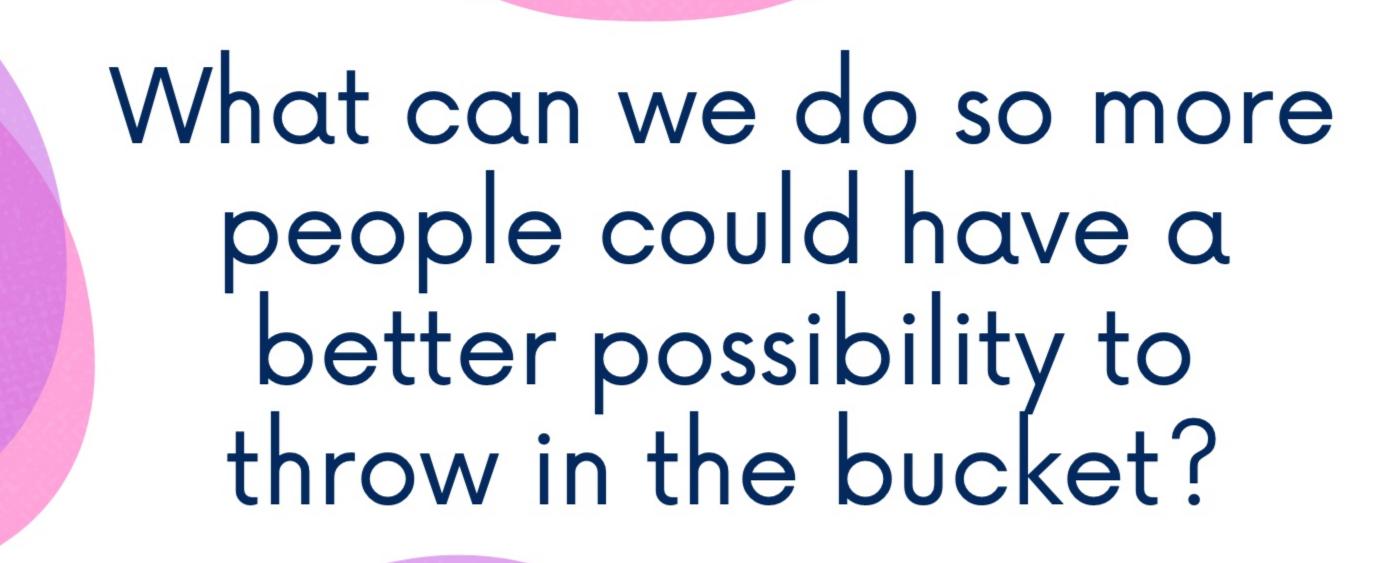




How were you feeling when the bucket was out of reach because of the place you had chosen?



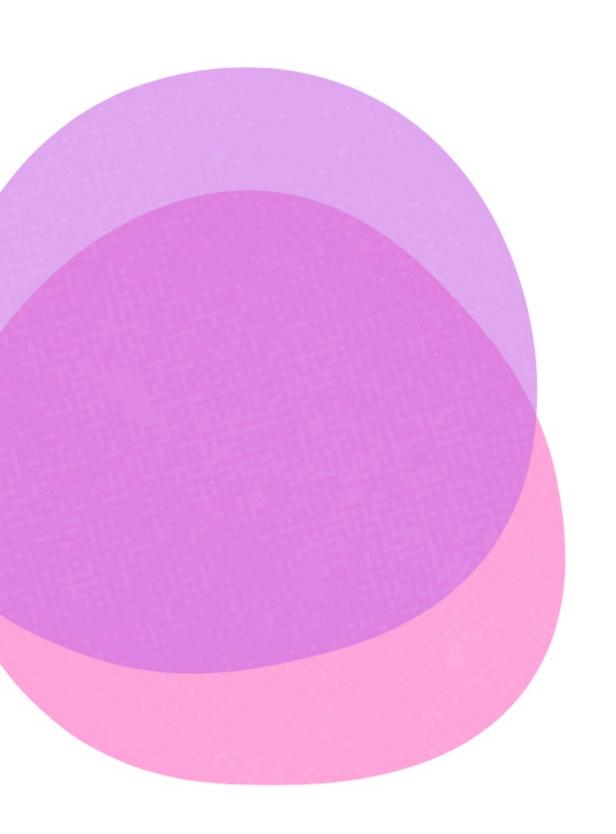
When you were closer to the bucket and it was easier for you to "make the goal", were you thinking about the people who were too far away?
