SUMMARY	Video concerning gender inequalities in Europe and Central Asia. "Over the past years, we have increased our efforts to address gender inequality and its impact on women and girls. In UNICEF's Europe and Central Asia region, where every 1 in 7 person is a girl, many are still denied the opportunities to participate and progress. We are still far from gender equality- we still have 1 in 4 girls and women subjected to violence at home, in school, online and in public spaces, 1 in 6 adolescent girls are not in education employment or training, 1 in 10 girls still marry before they reach 18, over 2 million girls are out of school. Their aspirations and potential are undervalued and unrecognised. COVID-19 has increased their inequalities and barriers. a doubling of efforts is required to ensure that none of them are left behind as we build back better"
